Guidance and Conditions for Bursary Applications

Who is eligible?

Applications are welcomed from any PhD or post-doctoral student studying at an academic institution irrespective of their nationality. The applicant is preferably an RSC or SCI member or member of a *National Adhering Organisation of the EFMC and is encouraged to present a short talk at the event (applications from those submitting short talk abstracts will be favoured). Applications must be endorsed by the student's supervisor. Bursary applications are also invited from RSC, SCI or EFMC members who are of working age, but currently unemployed. We also welcome bursary applications from those who may have difficulty funding themselves or whose organisations may have difficulty funding their attendance.
