

Michele Marinò, *University of Pisa*

Associate Professor, Department of Clinical and Experimental Medicine, UO Endocrinology II, University of Pisa, Azienda Ospedaliero Universitaria Pisana, Head of the Center for the Study and Treatment of Graves' Orbitopathy Michele Marinò graduated in Medicine and Surgery in 1991 and specialized in Endocrinology and Metabolic Diseases in 1996, at the University of Pisa. He completed his training at the Pathology Research Laboratory of the Massachusetts General Hospital, Harvard Medical School (1997-2000) as a Post-Doctoral Fellow, obtaining the Grant of the American Thyroid Association in 1999. From 2000 to 2003 he was a staff Physician at the Azienda Ospedaliero-Universitaria Pisana. From 2004 to 2018 he was a Researcher at the Department of Clinical and Experimental Medicine, Endocrinology Unit I, University of Pisa. In 2014 he obtained the National Scientific Qualification to the rank of Associate Professor. Since 2018 he has been Associate Professor in Endocrinology at the Department of Clinical and Experimental Medicine, Endocrinology Unit II, University of Pisa. Michele Marinò is the Head of the Hospital Day and the Outpatient Clinic for the study and treatment of Graves' Orbitopathy. His clinical activity concerns in particular thyroid diseases and Graves' Orbitopathy. His research activity concerns the pathogenesis and therapy of Graves' Orbitopathy and the synthesis of thyroid hormones, for which he has obtained PRIN funding from the Ministry of University and Scientific Research as Head of an Operative Unit and as National Coordinator, from the American Thyroid Association and the University of Pisa. In addition to various Book Chapters, Michele Marinò is the author of numerous publications in peer-reviewed International Journals, most of which as first or last author. Michele Marinò is a former member of the Executive Committee of the European Group On Graves' Orbitopathy (EUGOGO), and is a Member of the European Thyroid Association, the American Thyroid Association, the European Society of Endocrinology, the Italian Society of Endocrinology, the Italian Thyroid Association and the Association of Endocrine Students of Pisa. From 2004 to 2015 he was the Coordinating Editor-in-Chief and from 2015 to 2018 the Central Editor-in-Chief of the Journal "l'Endocrinologo" (Springer); he is a member of the Editorial Board of the Journal Of Endocrinological Investigation, Thyroid and European Thyroid Journal; he has served as a Reviewer for the main International Journals in the field of endocrinology and cellular and molecular biology. Michele Marinò carries out his Teaching Activity in the Integrated Course of Endocrinology and in the School of Specialization in Endocrinology and Metabolic Diseases of the Faculty of Medicine and Surgery of the University of Pisa.
