Diego Strianese is Professor of Ophthalmology at the University of the Naples Federico II – He is the Head of the Oculoplastic and Orbital tertiary referral centre at the University Hospital Federico II– He is the Chair of the Residency Program in Ophthalmology. He earned his medical degree, summa cum laude, and completed his residency in ophthalmology at the University of Naples Federico II, He received the title PhD title in maxillo-facial and orbital diseases for the the research in prognostic factors in Orbital malignancies. He was clinical and research fellow in orbital disease at the University of British Columbia under the mentorship of Prof Jack Rootman. From 2015 to 2017 he has been Adjunct Professor of Ophthalmology at the Johns Hopkins University – Wilmer eye Hospital- He has been for 5 years Head of the Orbital Unit at King Khaled Eye Specialist Hospital Riyadh –Saudi Arabia. From 2017 to 2020 He has been Head of the CME Department at KKESH. His top areas of expertise are Thyroid Eye Disease, Lacrimal Gland Tumor, and Orbital Vascular Malformation, He co-authored over 100 peer reviewed articles, He is member of the Editorial Board of OPRS and Orbit journals. Prof. Strianese is an active member of several professional organizations, including the European Society of Ophthalmic Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery (ESOPRS), The prestigious Orbital International Society (member by invitation only) and as committee member of the International Thyroid Eye Disease ITEDS. He participates in international panels addressing orbital diseases and surgical innovations, contributing to guideline development and research collaborations.
