Dr. Konuk is born in 1973 in Ankara. He completed my primary and secondary education at TED Ankara College and Ankara Atatürk Anadolu High School, and my medical education at Ankara University Faculty of Medicine in 1996, which I entered in 1990. In 1996, he took the 2nd place in Turkey in the Medical Specialization Examination and won the Gazi University Faculty of Medicine, Department of Ophthalmology and specialized between 1996 and 2001. He has been working in executive committee of Turkish Ophthalmological Association since 2015, and currently he is a member of the board. He is the representative of the European Thyroid Ophthalmopathy group “European Group on Graves Ophthalmopathy (EUGOGO)” in Turkey since 2016. He is the Chief of Ophthalmic Plastic and Reconstructive unit in the Department of Ophthalmology in Gazi University Medical School. He is mainly interested in orbital and adnexal diseases especially Graves Ophthalmopathy. He has 49 PubMed listed publications mainly on Graves ophthalmopathy, and his current h index is 17.
