Milos Zarkovic, University of Belgrade

Professor Miloš Žarković is a full professor of Internal Medicine and Head of Postgraduate Studies in Endocrinology at the Faculty of Medicine, University of Belgrade. He leads the department dedicated to thyroid diseases at the Clinic for Endocrinology in Belgrade. He manages the Graves' Orbitopathy Center, which is part of the European Group for Graves' Orbitopathy (EUGOGO). Additionally, he serves as the Director of the Department for Scientific Research, Educational Activities, and Human Resources at the University Clinical Centre of Serbia. Professor Žarković is the President of the Serbian Thyroid Society and previously served as Secretary of the European Group for Graves' Orbitopathy. He is a member of the European Thyroid Association's Guidelines and Publications Board and currently leads a working group developing the Serbian National Guide for Good Clinical Practice for Thyroid Nodules and Thyroid Cancer. He has published in major endocrinology journals and regularly reviews for these publications. An active member of various professional organisations, he is associated with the European Society of Endocrinology, Serbian Thyroid Society, Serbian Endocrine Society, European Thyroid Association (ETA), European Group on Graves' Orbitopathy (EUGOGO), the Endocrine Society (United States), and the American Thyroid Association. Professor Žarković has organised numerous national meetings and seminars, as well as several national thyroid ultrasound courses. Notably, he was the President of the Local Organizing Committee for the 40th Annual Meeting of the European Thyroid Association in 2017.
