## **EED 2026 Carer and accessibility conference grants**

### ***Who is eligible?***

The grant is only available for attending EED2026 in Glasgow, UK, and will only be awarded once applicants have completed conference registration (note that payment is not required at the time of registration). Presentation of a talk or poster at the conference is a condition of eligibility. If oversubscribed priority may be given to early-career researchers and first-time attendees.

We are not able to accept applications from countries where UK government sanctions would prevent payment of an award (see [here](#) for information on the countries affected).

### ***What type of expenditure can be funded?***

Financial assistance is available to 1) offset caring costs incurred by attendees due to conference attendance, or 2) contribute toward additional attendance costs created by individual needs such as disability or medical requirements.

### ***What is the maximum value of each bursary?***

The grant award will be a maximum of £500 and the scientific committee will rank and select proposals according to the availability of budget. We are able to finance in the order of ten awards.
