Abstract Submission Guidelines

Authors wishing to submit an abstract for an oral or poster presentation are requested to submit a maximum of 250 words for the abstract title and abstract text in English.

Oral or Poster Categories

Evolution of Echinoderms

Morphology & Physiology

Ecology & Climate Change

Genomics & Developmental Biology

Other

If your abstract does not seem to fit into one of these categories please pick 'other' or whichever category seems closest. Presentations will be selected on grounds of general scientific worth and not on their fit to these categories.

All abstracts need to be submitted via the online abstract submission form.

When submitting your abstract, please note the following important instructions:

- Without exception, late submissions will not be accepted after **Midnight (GMT), Monday 2nd February 2026**
- Authors will be advised of the decision by the middle of February 2026
- All presenters (poster and oral) will be required to register separately and pay the appropriate registration fee
- At the time of submitting your abstract, you will be asked to select the type of presentation (talk or poster) you would like to give

Talk Presentations

Talks will be 15 minutes long. (12 minute presentation + 3 minutes for questions)

Poster Presentations

Posters will be on display throughout the conference. There will also be allocated Poster Sessions.

If you intend to submit an abstract for Poster Presentation, please note the following:

Poster boards are 2m high and 1m wide. It is recommended that posters do not exceed 90cm wide and 180cm high.
