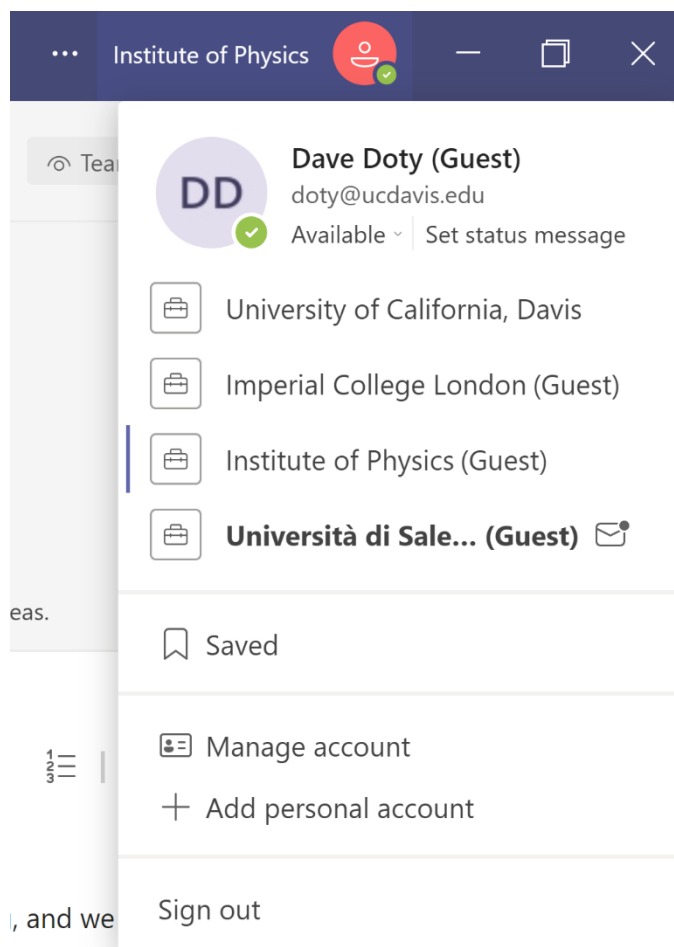


Instructions for virtual participation

The FNANO 2021 conference will use Zoom for the talks and business meeting and Microsoft Teams for the posters, announcements, online chat and break rooms. If you registered, you should have already received an invitation to join Teams, but if not, please contact Keenda Sisouphanh (keenda.sisouphanh@iop.org) as soon as possible.

Please sign into Microsoft Teams (installing it first if you don't already have it: <https://www.microsoft.com/en-us/microsoft-teams/group-chat-software>). Once signed in, ensure that "Institute of Physics" is selected in the upper-right corner. If you have used Microsoft Teams previously for other purposes, a different organization may be selected, and you will have to switch to Institute of Physics; please contact Keenda Sisouphanh (keenda.sisouphanh@iop.org) if Institute of Physics is not available as an option in the top-right corner (depending on your version of Teams, you may have to click a button such as "Switch account"):


