We would like to invite you to participate in the 8th Joint European Magnetism Symposia (JEMS 2016) taking place at the Scottish Exhibition and Conference Centre (SECC), Glasgow, in August 2016. JEMS is the most important and comprehensive conference on magnetism in Europe.

The Joint European Magnetism Symposia has evolved over the last 15 years into a premier scientific forum for presenting the latest cutting-edge developments in magnetism and magnetic materials research. The conference has a breadth of topics ranging from the fundamental to the applied, and exemplifying the diversity of approach inherent to the European context.

Topics range across all areas of current interest and include strongly correlated systems, materials for energy and biomedical applications, spintronics, ultrafast optical switching, chiral spin materials and magnonics.

An exhibition will be held alongside the conference from Sunday 21 to Tuesday 23 August. Exhibitors will have the opportunity to meet with more than 600 academics and other organisations to discuss their latest research, products and services.

The exhibition hall will be the central meeting point for all delegates as registration, refreshments and posters will be located in this area. A welcome reception and an exhibitor reception will be held in the hall on Sunday 21 and Tuesday 23 August, respectively.

We expect between 600 and 800 participants to attend JEMS 2016 from across Europe, including academics, industrial researchers and students.

Location

The exhibition will be held in halls 1 and 2 at the Scottish Exhibition and Conference Centre in the centre of Glasgow. 
